

OZHover 2025



1. The site as per the pic above has been secured. This gives us approx. 150M of hovercraft accessible shoreline plus parking for trailers etc on the Eastern side of the road.
2. One side of our rally site is bounded by a drain/creek.. It's the intention to mark the other side with some poles and hi Vis tape which is O.K. with park management.
3. The park and extensive shoreline is all privately owned and gated in and out meaning security is quite good and together with relative remoteness I think it should be fine to leave craft at the rally site overnight if desired. Otherwise it will also be O.K. to hover back to park on the foreshore closer to our camp sites.
4. I've secure a discount of 20% if we exceed 15 bookings. (a "booking" means per site or cabin even if secured in one transaction)
5. The waterfront sites (those on the curves next to the lake , both powered and unpowered, have been reserved for our group after bookings open for a year later i.e. They will remain reserved for us for month of October 24 (so as to book a year or so later) . Also some cabins close by. The idea is to have at least a core group near the water.... If you'd like to have one of these sites make sure to contact the park to make a

booking/pay deposit during this coming October not forgetting to mention why you are making the booking!

6. We can book the "function room" which can seat up to 100 people for our Saturday night dinner at a reasonable rate. Park management have also suggested catering companies that could take care of feeding us all on site. The later has yet to be followed up but I feel confident that we can secure a nice dinner!

7. The Friday night BYO "meat and great" BBQ should be no issue using one set of the two 4 x 2 BBQ's at the complex at park centre. Plenty of seating and also a big fire to sit around.... Perhaps the later shared with others in the park but can't see too much of a problem with that.

8. The park is dog/pet friendly in general. This also includes some cabins but as the cabins are currently being refurbished they can't say which of these are going to be pet friendly at this stage.

9. At this time of year all "family activities" at the park will be operational.. i.e. pool, jumping pillow, tennis courts, etc etc... (see website) . The café will also be operational and , if we give them enough warning, they could do Pizza's for us for Sunday lunch that we could bring down to the rally site..
